Thanks to the generosity of the FCSI Educational Foundation and our Corporate members, we are offering \$1,000 US grants to help defray the cost of attending the 2012 Conference. Those eligible for the grants include non-FCSI members demonstrably at the beginning of their careers in the foodservice and hospitality consulting profession (less than 5 years) and Associate members of FCSI where a more senior consultant member (FCSI Professional or Senior Associate) has already registered to attend this conference.

The intent of this grant is to encourage younger, emerging consultants to attend the conference together with their principal(s) where they can expand their knowledge, expand their network and be encouraged to become actively involved in the Society.

The grant may be used to cover:

- Registration Fee (includes conference meals)

Depending upon where you live the grant may or may not cover all of your registration, lodging and transportation. Only the actual expenses will be reimbursed. Any expenses over the \$1,000 US grant are the responsibility of the recipient.
